## K-6 PRINCIPAL

Happy New Year to everyone! The students have returned to school with smiles on their faces and focused on their schoolwork. In these past three days I have loved being out back in the morning and afternoon calling out names and seeing everyone back in our school. I have also gotten to substitute in a few classes and the learning and engagement of the students is palpable. This subbing was among the most enjoyable teaching I have ever been privileged to do. Our teachers and students care so much about learning, thinking and sharing. It really feels like a school that belongs to all of us and will help our children live full and fulfilling lives. I hope that it does.

The word is getting out about just how strong our community and partnership is and this week we will have several more visitors who are coming to learn more about our extraordinary school. The lottery is coming up in about a month. If you have a sibling please do not forget to submit their application. Currently enrolled students do not need to reapply but please fill in your intent to return forms which will be going home soon.

The weather is cold and snowy and there have been some questions about when the children go outside. We have one temperature rule and that is that the students go out when the temperature is above 20 degrees. On blustery days we may determine that the wind makes it too cold with the temperatures in the 20 's but in general we try to get everyone out. When the students are able to get the fresh air and play outdoors they learn better and are happier. Levels I, II, and III require the students to have coats, snow pants, hats and gloves to go on the hill. Level IV and the High School require coats to go outside.

This brings me to the lost and found, which is overflowing the hooks. On Friday January $15^{\text {th }}$ we will donate any clothing that is left in the lost and found. Tonight after the Parents Association meeting I went through the almost 100 articles of clothing and I found two names. I joyfully put those two pieces of clothing in the children's classrooms. Of the 100 articles of clothing ten are winter coats with wonderful places to put names, and no names. Kids get hot when they play and the lockers are small, please help us by labeling the coats and the hats and the boots. One of my early pledges to help make the school clean was to keep the back door nicely swept (now shoveled) and the lost and found useable,-useful and neat. I have done all right on the sweeping but the lost and found is a disappointment.

Tonight at the Parents Association there were many lively and interesting discussions and as the conversation was going on I noticed that I was the only male and I would like some input from men on how we could be more welcoming to men.
