Each day our students K-12 do amazing work in classrooms, on fields and playgrounds, and in the world around them. Our mission of inspiring every student to excel in academics, service, and life may be found in the day-to-day experiences or in marked achievements that leave a lasting impression.

Today twenty-one members of our senior class received notification that they have been awarded the John and Abigail Adams Scholarship. The Adams Scholarship provides students with a tuition waiver to a Massachusetts state college or university. The award which covers tuition, but not fees or housing, provides students with considerable financial support during four years of undergraduate study. It is a great honor reflecting years of academic

The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education has identified students who have accomplished these rigorous requirements:

- score at the Advanced performance level on one of the three high school state assessment tests in ELA, Mathematics, or STE (Biology, Chemistry, Introductory Physics, or Technology/Engineering); and
- score at the Proficient level or higher on the remaining two high school state assessment tests; and
- have combined scores from the three tests that place them in the top 25 percent of students in the graduating class in their district.

Our students are working hard and succeeding. To be awarded a scholarship, students must be in the top 25 percent of their class or the senior class of their sending district. It is commendable that 34 percent of our seniors have been awarded this distinction. We could not be more proud of the young men and women who have achieved high academic honors as members of the SSCPS Class of 2018. Congratulations John and Abigail Adams Scholars.
