From the Health Office

Now that the cold weather is upon us here are a few reminders:

All students need to remain home if they are experiencing vomiting, diarrhea, and/or a fever over 100 degrees. Students may return to school when they have been fever free for 24 hours without medication (Tylenol/Advil). Students may return to school when symptom-free (NO vomiting/diarrhea) for 24 hours. Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well.

The students go outside in all types of weather and only stay in for heavy rain or temps below 20 degrees. Please dress your child appropriate for the weather and to be outside. All students should have an extra pair of clothes in their locker, in case they get wet or muddy. If you have not done so, please send in extra clothes for your child to keep at school.
