# **Meet the Instructional Leadership Team**

## **School Administration**

### Walter Duncan | Dean of Students (K-6)

Walter Duncan has been an educator since 1998, teaching English Language Arts and Spanish in schools across Detroit, Los Angeles, Washington DC, and the Boston area. In addition to his classroom work, he co-founded Quick Key, an education technology company that won the 2018 Visionary Award from the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce before being sold in 2019. Walter received his Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Fitchburg State University in 2024 and has been teaching Spanish at SSCPS since 2019. He now serves as Dean of Students for Grades K–6, bringing his experience as both a teacher and innovator to help students thrive academically and personally.



## Maria Lappas | Principal (K-6)

Maria has been a world language educator for fifteen years and has taught in Greece, Spain, and the United States. She received her BS in Marketing from Bentley University, as well as a Master of Spanish from Simmons College and a Master of Teaching Greek as a Second Language from the University of Nicosia. She is currently finishing her Educational Leadership program at Bridgewater State University and has worked as a Spanish Teacher at SSCPS since 2011. She started an independent Modern Greek School program in 2017 and is actively involved in the Greek-American community. She resides in Pembroke, MA with her husband and three sons.



## Jean-Paul Marcellus | Principal (7-8)

JP will continue his career at SSCPS in his new role as Principal, Grades 7-8. JP has been with us at SSCPS since 2019, serving as Assistant Principal (Grades 5-8), High School Athletic Director, P.E. Teacher, and Boys Varsity Basketball Coach. He received his BA in Business Management from Eastern Nazarene College and his Masters in Educational Leadership from Fitchburg State College.



## **Christophe Teulet-Cote | Principal (9-12)**

## Bus Dismissal Procedure 2025-2026

Below you'll find an overview of the Bus Dismissal/Pick-Up Procedures for the 2025-2026 school year, along with a map to help demonstrate the dismissal/pick-up process. Transportation registration, which includes student route assignments, will be emailed later this afternoon.

#### **Dismissal/Pickup Procedures**

Grades K-6   100 Longwater Circle	Grades 7-12   700 Longwater Drive

100 Longwater Drive (Grades K-6): Dismissal will begin for buses (1-8)

700 Longwater Drive (Grades 7-12): Dismissal will begin for buses (9-17)

After the buses are loaded, buses 1-8 will depart for 700, and buses 9-17 will depart for 100 to pick up the remaining students.

Carline dismissal will begin for 100 after the first round of buses (1-8) depart.

Carline dismissal will begin at 700 after the second round of buses depart.

# Procedure for 700 Longwater Drive (Grades 7-12) Dismissal (See Man)


There will be 3 carlines at 700 Longwater:

- The far right (green arrow) will be for Grades 7-8
- The double green arrow is for Grades 9-12

After the buses have completed pickup, cars for grades 7-8 will pick up around the traffic circle to the right of the building and exit, following the blue arrows.

After the buses have completed pick up, cars for grades 9-12 will pick up in front of the building, along the sidewalk.

If you are picking up students in both grades 7-8 and 9-12, pick up your 7-8th grade student first, then continue to the grade 9-12 pickup.

## From the Health Office

### Back to School | 2025-2026

If your student takes prescription medication during the school day, including epipens or inhalers, the medication will need to be dropped off to the school nurse by an adult. Medication cannot be sent on the bus with students. All medication needs to be accompanied by a new prescription medication form each year. Your doctor may fill out their own medication form, an Asthma Action Plan, Allergy Action Plan, or the school's <a href="Prescription Drug Form">Prescription Drug Form</a>. No medication can be accepted without the proper paperwork. Parents/guardians will also need to sign the form to give permission for medication to be administered in school. Students can not bring in over the counter medication. All medication needed at school must be held in the Health Office and have the proper paperwork in order for it to be administered at school. Please check expiration dates of medication before sending it in. Medication that expires during the school year will need to be replaced before it expires. Please reach out to your school nurse if you have any questions about medications.

If your student is planning on playing a school sport in the fall they must have a current physical dated within the past 13 months of the start of the sports season. Students who do not have a current physical will not be allowed to try out or participate in sports. You may submit health forms to:

Students entering Kindergarten, 4th, 7th, or 10th Grade must submit current physical forms and vaccine records.

The K through 6 school is a **peanut/nut free** building. Please make sure you do not send your child to school with any food that contains peanuts or nuts or the label reads "may contain nuts or traces of nuts". Caffeinated beverages are not allowed in the elementary school. Please send your student to school with a reusable water bottle as the school does not provide water bottles.

Please reach out to your school nurse and teacher if your student is sick. Students who have vomiting, diarrhea, or a fever of 100 or above need to remain out of school until the symptoms or fever have resolved for 24 hours. If your student has strep throat, conjunctivitis or any other contagious illness they will need to remain out until they have been on antibiotics for 24 hours. Students who develop any of these symptoms during the school day will need to be picked up from school promptly. Please make sure your contact information with the school is up to date. Absences can be reported to <a href="mailto:attendance@sscps.org">attendance@sscps.org</a>.

Level I students should have a full change of weather appropriate clothes that is kept at school.
