How to Apply

1. Request an Enrollment Packet or download it from www.sscps.org/admissions.
2. Visit one of our Open Houses on Saturday, November 14 from 1-3pm and Wednesday, January 13 from 5-7pm.
3. Submit the application including proof of residency and a birth certificate if applying for kindergarten.
4. Applications must be received by February 26, 2016 to be included in the Enrollment Lottery on Saturday, April 5, 2016.
5. Lottery results will be sent to all applicants by letter.
6. Accepted students must inform the school by March 5 of his or her enrollment decision.
