DESE Accountability Site Visit January 31, 2023

- Aim to gather information for a written report used as evidence when the school comes up for renewal in 2025.
- Looking at faithfulness to charter, student academic performance, and organizational viability.
- This visit looked closely for the mission, key design elements, and classroom instruction.
- Representatives from DESE conducted three focus groups, the Board of Trustees on January 26, and the Faculty and School Administration on January 31.
- Prior to the visit the school was asked to provide evidence of access and equity in communication, recruitment, and retention.

The full report will be sent in six to eight weeks. During the exit interview we were told the following summative statements from the January 31 site visit classroom visitations and the Faculty and School Administration focus groups:

 Stakeholders were "on the same page" concerning the school's mission statement, how that mission supports learning, and the importance of high quality instruction.
 In the majority of classrooms observed there was ample evidence of systems and structures highly conducive to learning.

3. In the majority of classrooms observed high expectations for all students were clearly evident.4. In the majority of classrooms observed the elements of high quality instruction were apparent.

Accepted students will receive an acceptance package and an invitation to attend an accepted student event in March.


Accepted student Letter of Intent due April 1, 2023

- All applicants will be invited to admissions events in January and February.




SSCPS and Massachusetts Enrollment Trends

Timeline

February 2023

The SSCPS Finance and Ad Hoc Facilities Committee meet to discuss campus needs and school budget.

March - May 2023

The SSCPS Board of Trustees deliberation on possibilities for a minor expansion and improvements in programming and facilities.

March - May 2023

The SSCPS Board of Trustees works with school administration to review family survey data and develop a communication plan for the school community.

July 2023

The SSCPS Board of Trustees votes on deciding whether or not to apply to the state for a minor charter amendment to increase student enrollment.

August 1, 2023 The school submits the minor amendment request to DESE.

Fall 2023

DESE approves, modifies, or denies the request.

March 2024

If the request is approved, the new growth plan is implemented in the Enrollment Lottery.

Spring/Summer 2024

Facilities improvements begin to accommodate the new student enrollment growth plan.
