(U//FOUO) Joint Situational Awareness Bulletin 6/6/2013: Suspicious Letters Being Sent to Schools *Prepared by the Boston Regional Intelligence Center, the Commonwealth Fusion Center and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.*

(U//FOUO) The Boston Police Department reported to the FBI that several schools in the City of Boston received letters with concerning language. Upon FBI review, the letters bear similarities in language to letters sent from a serial white powder mailer from the Dallas, Texas area. In March of 2012, several schools in Massachusetts received letters linked to the serial white powder mailer from Dallas, TX. That investigation involves the receipt of several hundred letters which also contained a threat and a powder.

(U//FOUO) The current letters contain references to WMD attacks, but not an express threat. Thus far, the current letters have not contained any substances. These letters received in Boston are the first in the nation matching this description but are potentially linked to the FBI Dallas investigation.

(U//FOUO) Below is a photograph of the envelope from one of the letters. The letter was postmarked June 3, 2013 at the North Texas TX P&DC, and bears an adhesive, pre-printed address label. No return address is listed.
