## <u>School Council</u> <u>Meeting Minutes</u> January 11, 2017

Meeting commenced at 3:43 p.m.

- 1) Substance Abuse Education Update
  - a. Presentation from Caron Treatment Centers 4/28
    - A one-time presentation for middle school and grades 9 and 10
    - Hopefully we can get some other presentations around the same time, especially for high school students nearing college.
    - We need to also reach out to grades 5 and 6 but this particular program, with the money we have available, addresses only grades 7-10.
    - The aim of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade education is to help students make "good choices" about many things, as opposed to inspiring curiosity about drugs by addressing them too directly.
  - b. Grant Application
    - Ellen, with Susan and Marianne, applied for a grant from CVS, asking for \$7,000 to pay for the Caron program and extend it to grade 12, as well as programs for teachers and for parents.
    - The answer should be in by January  $16^{\text{th}}$ .
  - c. Dept. of Public Health Materials
    - These were promised to us; a link is on the agenda.
    - The materials address primarily where abuse/addiction begins, with sports and other injuries, tooth extractions, etc., and advising parents and students to avoid using opiates to deal with these.
    - Deirdre quoted a statistic that on the South Shore one out of four people over 18 is addicted to opioids.
    - We are mandated to advise student athletes about the risks of opioid use.
    - The Hingham Rotary is "on standby" to possibly donate monies for education on opioid use.
  - d. This subject will be brought up again at the next meeting, hopefully with updates.
- 2) Student Handbook Revisions
  - One of the requirements of the School Council is an annual review of the Student Handbook.
  - This will happen after the SIP (below).
- 3) School Improvement Plan Revisions
  - Another requirement of School Council is an annual review of the SIP.
  - The Council goes over what they want to act on, what they want to change, what is no longer working.
  - The Council is asked to look over the SIP and come back next month with input.

- The Goals in the current version don't include Goal #2, which will be reintroduced at the next meeting for discussion; it involves facilities primarily.
- 4) The February meeting will be on the 15<sup>th</sup> (NOT the 8<sup>th</sup>) and March will be the 8<sup>th</sup>. April will be the 12<sup>th</sup>. May's will be the 10<sup>th</sup>.
  - The February and March meetings will be for reviewing the SIP, and the April and May meetings will be for going over the Handbook.
