- 1) <u>School Improvement Plan</u>
 - a. Goals to keep
 - Tabled until a future meeting
 - b. New goals
 - Digital literacy/computer science goal
 - (1) CS Engage grant is providing an opportunity in this area
 - (2) Not only about computer science courses but exposure
 - (3) Small grant for this year, hope to expand next year
 - (4) K-12
 - (5) Citadel grant to reimplement AP Computer Science
 - (6) Focus area under academic achievement
 - Social-Emotional Learning/relationship building/student behavior
 - (1) Professional development for teachers
 - (2) Life skills/anxiety/peer pressure
 - (3) Best Buddies-expansion to middle school
 - Financial literacy
 - (1) How is the work from the grant being continued across grades
 - Family engagement

2) Medical Emergency Response Plan

- a. Amendment to the statute
 - Statute now requires behavioral health emergencies to be included in the plan
 - Revised plan must be submitted by September 2024
- b. Model Plan
- c. Process for update
 - Review the plan prior to the next meeting
 - Angie will highlight information for next meeting from the model plan that we need to incorporate into our revised plan

- 3) Dual Enrollment
 - a. History of dual enrollment at SSCPS
 - Began in the early years of the school, students attended UMass Boston; released early from school to take these courses, cost covered by a grant
 - Grant ended, college course became part of the general budget
 - College course was especially important when the school was very small/had no AP courses, provided an opportunity for advanced coursework
 - Used Quincy college for many years, students took courses in the summer and weekends
 - With COVID there was a shift online
 - Coursework stronger/registration easier with Massasoit—comes with GPA requirement (2.5)
 - Transportation a challenge; offered Massasoit courses at school; limited choice
 - b. Current college course guidelines
 - No longer using Quincy
 - Challenge for students who do not meet the GPA/Accuplacer requirement
 - c. Commonwealth Dual Enrollment Partnership
 - CDEP grant and possible partnership with Bridgewater State
 - Teacher diversification grant and possible partnership w/BSU
 - BSU or SSCPS faculty teaching courses for college credit during the school day
 - Would provide opportunity for more courses for interested students in an affordable way
 - d. Read information about dual enrollment ahead of next meeting; possible change to high school Exit Standards to reflect change in coursework available at SSCPS and changes in how high school students access college coursework
