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<u>BEN KIMBALL SCHOLARSHIP</u>	Variable
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Eligibility: Rockland resident graduating who is on an I.E.P at the time of of graduation or has received SPED services during high school, or is furthering their education in the special education field. Applicant must have volunteered or been represented at the SPED tollbooth to have an application considered.

<u>ROCKLAND YOUTH FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING SCHOLARSHIP</u>	Varies
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Eligibility: Must have participated in football or cheerleading for RYF & C for at least one year. Please write ONE paragraph describing anytime volunteering by a student or parent.

<u>ROCKLAND YOUTH BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP</u>	4 @ \$250
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Eligibility: Scholarship available for both girls and boys who is a Rockland resident. Must have played at least 3 years in youth or travel and left in good standing. Applicants must have a strong academic must have a strong academic standing. Those that volunteered after leaving will take precedence.

<u>ROCKLAND LITTLE LEAGUE</u>	2 @ \$250
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Eligibility: Must have participated in the program for at least 3 years and left in good standing.

<u>ROCKLAND GIRLS SOFTBALL SCHOLARSHIP</u>	2 @ \$250
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Eligibility: Girls who have participated in Rockland Girls Town and Travel Softball programs and have continued through high school. Awarded to graduating seniors who are Rockland residents and are continuing their education.

\$500.00

Eligibility: A graduating male who has participated in Rockland Youth Soccer's Fall or Spring program. Scholarship Must be used for continuing education, public or private.

\$500.00

Eligibility: A graduating female who has participated in Rockland Youth Soccer's Fall or Spring program. Scholarship Must be used for continuing education, public or private.
